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### TRAVEL



Please note! The Catskills region has spotty cellular reception, at best. If you are relying on a GPS, we suggest that you leave it switched on and running for the duration of any trip.

Please be aware that August is the high season for tourists in the Catskills, and traffic leaving the Manhattan area can become heavy during rush hour and afternoons.

### <u>Arriving by car from New York (recommended)</u>

From Interstate-87 North, take Exit 19 towards NY-28 and the Rhinecliff Bridge. Merge onto NY-28 West (towards the mountains). Follow NY-28 to Arkville, NY. After entering Arkville, take a right on County Road 38 (Co Rd 38), and follow for 1 mile (1,6km) until the STOP sign at New York State Highway 30. Take a right onto NY-30 and follow for 8.4 miles (13,5km) to arrive at East Branch Farms, on the right hand side.

### Arriving by bus from New York

You can book travel on the Pine Hill Trailways bus line departing New York's Port Authority Bus Terminal (8th Ave. between 40th and 42nd Sts.) to the Fair St. stop in the village of Margaretville, NY.

Once in the Village of Margaretville, you will need a car to travel to Roxbury (about a 15 minutes drive). If you wish to rent a car once in the Catskills, we recommend Sensible Car Rental in Margaretville. The office is located at the Fair St. Trailways stop.

#### Arriving by train from New York (this option requires a carpool)

The current train lines do not service the Catskills region, but if you plan to carpool, we suggest taking the Amtrak Empire Service from Penn Station to Rhinecliff Station, Rhinebeck, NY. Another train+carpool option is to take the MTA's MetroNorth line from Grand Central Station to Poughkeepsie, NY.

Both Rhinecliff Station and Poughkeepsie Station are about a one to one and a half hours drive from Roxbury, respectively.

Veuillez noter que la région des Catskills est dotée d'un réseau cellulaire limité. Si vous utilisez un GPS, nous vous suggérons de ne pas le couper jusqu'à votre arrivée.

Soyez attentifs au fait que le mois d'août fait partie de la haute saison touristique dans les Catskills, et le trafic au départ de Manhattan peut devenir dense aux heures de pointe et les après-midis.

### Au départ de New York en voiture (recommandé)

De l'Interstate-87 North, prenez la sortie 19 en direction de NY-28 et Rhinecliff Bridge. Rejoignez la NY-28 West (vers les montagnes). Suivez la NY-28 jusqu'à Arkville, NY. En entrant dans Arkville, prenez à droite sur la County Road 38 (Co Rd 38) et suivez-la sur 1 mile (1,6 km) jusqu'au panneau STOP de la New York State Highway 30. Prenez ensuite à droite sur NY-30 et suivez la route pour 8,4 miles (13,5 km) pour arriver aux East Branch Farns, sur votre côté droit.

### Au départ de New York en bus

Vous pouvez voyager avec la ligne de bus Pine Hill Trailways au départ du terminal de bus de New York's Port Authority (8th Ave. entre 40th et 42nd Sts.) jusqu'au stop Fair St. dans le village de Margaretville, NY.

Une fois à Margaretville, vous aurez besoin d'une voiture pour aller jusqu'à Roxbury (environ 15 minutes de route). Si vous voulez louer une voiture une fois dans les Catskills, nous recommandons Sensible Car Rental à Margaretville. Le bureau se trouve au niveau de l'arrêt de bus.

### Au départ de New York en train (cette option nécessite un covoiturage)

La ligne de train présentement en service ne dessert pas la région des Catskills, mais si vous planifiez un covoiturage, nous vous suggérons l'Amtrak Empire Service de Penn Station jusqu'à Rhinecliff Station, Rhinebeck, NY.

Une autre option est le MTA Metro North de Grand Central Station pour Poughkeepsie, NY.

Les stations de Rhinecliff et Poughkeepsie sont à environ une heure et une heure et demie de route de Roxbury, respectivement.

### **Alternatives**

Les aéroports les plus proches sont ceux d'Albany International (71 miles / 114 km) et Steward International (90 miles / 145 km). Vous pouvez louer une voiture au départ de chacun de ces aéroports.










## STAY


